Dear Student:

The Association of University of Puerto Rico Alumni and Friends Abroad (UPRAA) invites you to apply for the UPRAA/Dominion Power Scholarship and congratulates you for your efforts in pursuing your studies.

The UPRAA/Dominion Power Scholarship Fund will award Hispanic students enrolled in the Mayaguez Campus who have demonstrated academic merit, commitment to public service, and financial need to help **cover tuition cost** for undergraduate and/or graduate studies at the University of Puerto Rico (UPR), **Mayaguez campus**.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Postgraduate studies eligibility requirements in P.R.:

- Be accepted for enrollment as a full-time graduate student for the 2016-2017 academic year at the UPR **Mayaguez campus**.
- Be accepted for enrollment as a full-time graduate student for the 2016-2017 academic year with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.00
- Be qualified to obtain Financial Aid. Financial qualifications will be determined by the UPR financial aid office or the UPRAA Scholarship committee

Students must submit the following to be considered:

- UPRAA/Dominion Power application form
- Acceptance letter from the University of Puerto Rico, **Mayaguez campus**
- An official GPA certification/transcript sent directly to us from the registrar's office (**student copies will not be accepted**)
- Two letters of recommendation (from a professor/advisor or manager) with original signature
- A copy of the Financial Aid qualification document or 2015 tax return document
- An 800 word essay. (**Topic included in the application form**)
- Two (2) 2x2 photo

2. Undergraduate studies eligibility requirements in the Continental U.S:

- Complete High School with a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.00 and be accepted for enrollment as a full-time student for the 2016-2017 academic year at the University of Puerto Rico, **Mayaguez campus**.
- Be qualified to obtain Financial Aid

Students must submit the following to be considered:

- UPRAA/Dominion Power application form
- Acceptance letter from the University of Puerto Rico, **Mayaguez campus**.
- An official GPA Certification/transcript sent directly to us from the registrar's office (**student copies will not be accepted**)
- Two letters of recommendation (from professors/advisor or managers) with original signature
- A copy of the Financial Aid qualification document or 2015 tax return document
- An 800-word essay (**Topic included in the application form**)
- Two (2) 2x2 photo

To ensure your application receives full consideration, you should:

- Carefully read the information included in the UPRAA/Dominion Power scholarship package
- Follow the application instructions and include **ALL** required documents with original signature/stamps for applicable documents
- Review and proofread your essay
- Complete and submit the materials requested in a timely manner

UPRAA is an organization created to establish a network of University of Puerto Rico (UPR) Alumni in the Continental U.S. and abroad, develop and conduct programs and initiatives for the benefit of the UPR alumni, and support the educational goals of the UPR system. Selection Criteria

Applicants will be evaluated based on:

- Academic record
- Financial need
- Recommendations (from a professor/advisor or manager)
- Essay response
- Interview (if required, finalists only)

Application Preparation

- Use the official application form or a photocopy of the form. Use a computer or typewriter to complete your application. Applications that are illegible will be disqualified.
- Answer all questions
- Submit Financial Aid documents to the Financial Aid Office. **Send a copy with your application.**
- Submit the documents listed below
 - UPRAA/Dominion Power application form
 - Acceptance letter from the University of Puerto Rico, **Mayaguez** campus
 - An official GPA certification/transcript sent directly to us from the registrar's office (**student copies will not be accepted**) (should include GPA)
 - 800-word Essay
 - Two (2) 2x2 photo
 - A copy of the Financial Aid qualification document or 2015 tax return document
 - Letters of recommendation
 - Two letters of recommendation (in English or Spanish)
 - A professor, school/university advisor or manager must complete and sign the letters
 - A relative **MAY NOT** provide letters

Application Deadline

All materials must be submitted as one package and postmarked by **October 1, 2016**. Applications received after this date will **NOT** be considered.

Interviews

The UPRAA Scholarship Committee will interview finalists if needed. Interviews will be conducted in person or by phone during the month of October 2016.

Awards

- The scholarships will be awarded for one year and are to be used to help cover tuition expenses, books and other related expenses
- Awardees must be enrolled in the UPR, **Mayaguez campus**.
- Awardees must remain in good standing throughout the academic year
- Scholarships award amounts will be decided by the UPRAA scholarship committee
- Any unused funds by the student must be returned to the UPRAA Scholarship Fund
- Students will provide an expense report at the end of the year detailing how the funds were allocated

Award Notification

Awardees will be notified not later than the last week of October by e-mail and/or telephone. Therefore, it is extremely important that applicants provide the correct e-mail address and telephone numbers on the application form.

Award Ceremony

Awardees will need to make themselves available for the award ceremony. Details of the activity will be sent to the winners via e-mail and/or telephone.
