

## History of UPR KC Implementation




- April June 2012: Meetings with UPRM and UPR officials on e-Research needs
- June 26, 2012: Proposal to UPR Central Admin "KC Implementation at UPRM and MSC"
- August 2012: Recruited Omar Soto, GS as Tech/Developer
- Sept 25, 2012: Meeting with Indiana U (IU) Staff
- October 2012: Proposal Approved; Attended Kuali Days 2012


## Introduction to Kuali Coeus (KC) 10 Good Reasons to Install KC

#### Reasons to Install Kuali Coeus

- Standardizes and increases the efficiency and accuracy of grants administration, including research accounting
  - → Reduces cost of administering grants over time
  - → Reduces liability to the University and investigators
- Reduces paper usage and costs (of proposal writing and post-award processes)
  - -> contribute to slowing global climate change.



## 10 Good Reasons to Install Kuali Coeus Proposal Development

- Saves time in circulating proposals (internal proposal routing)
- 2. Increases accuracy of proposals & its records
- 3. Provides a **single location** for all proposal and grant information
- 4. Provides controlled access via web
- **5. Allows e-submission (e.g. Grants.gov)** Easier to conform to automated systems over time
- **6. Eases resubmissions** former proposals easily accessible & copied



## (Cont.) 10 Good Reasons to Install Kuali Coeus Proposal Development

- 7. Allows for compliance tracking (Conflict of Interest system; IRB, IACUC requirements)
- 8. Provides a negotiation module -to track and document proposal changes (Negotiation Module)
- 9. Simplifies creation of Post Award (Grant) Records due to available proposal records
- I 0. Eases post-award administration (upon Award Module implementation future phase)






### What is Kuali Coeus?

- Cradle-to-grave research administration system, based on MIT's Coeus and supports:
  - Pre-award (proposals, budgets, Grants.gov)
  - Post-award (contracts, grants, negotiations, report tracking, subcontracting)
  - Research Compliance (IRB, IACUC, FCOI)
- Uses a single database; allows integration among modules/campus stakeholders
- Can be linked with financial systems (eg. Kuali Financial or others)







## UPRM KC Implementation Working Test Bed





### VIVO


- VIVO, an open-source system created at Cornell, is expected to become the UPRM <u>institutional</u> <u>resource</u> for research profiling.
- ...will help faculty, researchers and students discover interests and make connections, using what is called an 'entity-relationship ontology model' to organize and present information on people research and education activities.
- "... is populated with information about researchers, allowing them to highlight areas of expertise, display academic credentials, visualize academic networks and display information such as publications, grants, teaching, service, and more.
- information can be programmatically imported from data sources such as institutional records, local repositories, bibliographic and grant databases.
