

### Puerto Rico Teacher Certification Exam Results 2014-2016

The following table compares the passing rates of UPRM graduates on the basic battery of Puerto Rico Teacher certification exams over the past three years with all test takers. The basic battery includes Fundamental Knowledge and Communication Skills and Professional Skills. The Professional Skills Exam is offered at Secondary (middle and high school) and Elementary levels. The exams are offered on a Saturday in March of each calendar year. A subsequent table provides a year by year comparison and greater detail.

The average passing rate for UPRM teacher candidates taking the Fundamental Knowledge and Communications Skills exam over the past three years is 94%. This reflects the UPRM TPP emphasis on breadth and depth of content knowledge and the rigor of UPRM general education requirements.

The average passing rate for UPRM teacher candidates taking the Professional Skills Exam over the past three years is 89%. Six UPRM teacher candidates have taken the Elementary Level over the past three years.

Based on UPRM teacher candidate performance on certification exams (80%) and other criteria (20%) the Puerto Rico Department of Education rated the UPRM Teacher Preparation Program as Excellent in 2014 (see 1.1.6B). The next rating will be issued in 2017 and the UPRM TPP target is an Exemplary rating.

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Historically, a UPRM teacher candidate has made the highest score on 1 to 4 Puerto Rico Teacher Certification exams each year. Given that UPRM teacher candidates account for 5 - 20% of the test takers for any one certification exam, this attests to their consistent quality. For the past six years a UPRM teacher candidate has made one of the top three scores on the Secondary Level Professional Skills Exam including a perfect score in 2012 and two perfect scores in 2010. The following table includes A UPRM candidate made the top<sup>T</sup> score on the Fundamental Knowledge and Communication Skills exam in 2015. The following table compares UPRM candidate performance with all Puerto Rico on the basic battery of Puerto Rico Teacher Certification Exams over the past three years.
