The following tables show the number of credits and average GPA of candidates completing teaching practice in licensure area courses taken at UPRM. The tables show both total licensure area credits and licensure area credits in upper level courses (4000+) and the corresponding GPAs. Since the tables include candidates that transferred from other institutions, the minimum number of credits taken by a candidate at UPRM does not represent the minimum number of credits taken in the licensure area and GPAs are limited to those courses taken at UPRM. The Puerto Rico Department of Education requires a minimum of 21 credits in the licensure area for certification.

Over the past three academic years Agricultural Education teacher candidates averaged 65 credits in upper level agriculture courses with a GPA of 3.15 clearly showing a depth and breadth of preparation in the field. UPRM is the only institution in Puerto Rico that prepares Agriculture teachers and as such has historically high expectations for its candidates' performance and community involvement.

Over the past three academic years Physical Education teacher candidates averaged 57 credits in Physical Education courses with 30 or more credits in upper level courses with an average GPA of 3.05. This extensive preparation in the field includes two motor development courses. Note: The two Physical Education candidates with less than 40 credits in Physical Education at UPRM over the past three years began their academic careers at UPRM in 2007 and 2009 respectively, studied at another institution before returning to complete their bachelor's degrees at UPRM.

The prior table shows that over the past three academic years Social Science and History teacher candidates averaged 54 and 45 credits respectively in their licensure area with average GPAs of 3.66 and 3.70. This represents a bread and depth of preparation in content far above the norm. Note: One of the three Social Science candidates with less than 40 credits in Social Science at UPRM over the past three years completed 57 credits in history. The other two re-entered UPRM after working and studying elsewhere for several years.

The table at right shows that over the past three academic years English teacher candidates averaged 68 credits in English including 28 credits in upper level courses with GPAs of 3.54 and 3.56. On average UPRM English teacher candidates take a depth and breadth of content preparation into the classroom well above the norm. Note: the one English teacher candidate in 2015-16 who completed only 30 credits in English at UPRM was a transfer student who became a certified social science teacher in 2013.

The following table shows the average number of credits and GPA of UPRM teacher candidates in other fields. The average ranges from 30 in Physics to 58 in Business Education. In all cases, the breadth and depth of preparation is well beyond the 21 credits required by the Puerto Rico Department of Education. The minimum number of credits in specialization arise from the alternate preparation routes available at UPRM that include transfers from other institutions and teacher candidates pursuing degrees in related fields such as Chemical Engineering (Chemistry), Industrial Engineering (mathematics), and Mechanical Engineering (Physics), etc. The specific content course and grade data for candidates who completed a bachelor's degree in content at another institution (alternate route) are not included in 1.1.5b.
