

PRDE Standards and Expectations and Curricular maps are based on college and career-ready- standards

The Puerto Rico Core Standards, distributed in 2014, were developed by the Puerto Rico Department of Education as college and career ready standards: "The Puerto Rico Core Standards for the English Program are divided into five distinct standards: Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing, and Language. Each standard consists of both College and Career Readiness (CCR) expectations and grade level indicators. The CCR expectations and grade-specific indicators are necessary complements – the former provides broad expectations, the latter provides additional specificity – that together defines the skills and competencies that all students must master. The PRCS require preparing students for College and Career Readiness (CCR) expectations which identify what students are expected to master by the end of grade 12 while the grade level indicators identify what students are expected to master at a particular grade level." (Puerto Rico *Core Standards* English Program 2014. p. 13.)

"Content standards and grade expectations of Puerto Rico describe annual expectations for learning and academic performance of students in grades from kindergarten to twelfth in the basic materials to achieve outcomes related to post-secondary education and professional expectations." (Estándares de Contenido y Expectativas de Grado de Puerto Rico Programa de Ciencias 2014. p. 15.).
