- 3. Para considerarse CI tienen que estar de forma escrita y ser revisada por pares o practicantes. Por eso es importante documentar todo.



- Significant participation in business professional associations, professional standard-setting bodies, or policymaking bodies.
- Practice-oriented intellectual contributions, as detailed in Standard 8.
- Relevant, active service on boards of directors.
- Documented continuing professional education experiences.
- Participation in professional events that focus on the practice of business management, and related issues.
- Participation in other activities that place faculty in direct engagement with business or other organizational leaders.



- Relevant, active editorships with academic, professional, or other business or management publications.
- Service on editorial boards or committees.
- Validation of SP status through leadership positions in recognized academic societies, research awards, academic fellow status, invited presentations, etc.
- Development and presentation of continuing professional education activities or executive education programs.
- Significant participation in academic associations, professional standard setting bodies, or policymaking bodies.

- Case Studies Entered as Intellectual Contribution only if peer or editorially reviewed and should include an instructor's manual. Note: If Case study is published in a Peer-Reviewed Journal, enter as a "journal Article" – If case study is in a textbook, case collection, or similar outlet; enter as Al Contribution Type: Written Case with Instructional Material.
- Other Teaching Materials Entered as an Intellectual Contribution only if publically available and has gone through some type of peer or editorial review process. Other teaching materials include instructional software, published study guides and instructor's manuals, etc. (Al Contribution Types: Instructor's Manual, Software Instructional; Study Guide)
- Professional practice standards, or public policy This category includes work that faculty members with expertise in a specific area do for a professional/regulatory body, licensing, or certification decision. You will need to be able to provide evidence of impact on professional practice or public will. This category includes scholarly items such as substantial work on new professional standards (for CFA, AICPA, IRS, etc.), white papers, briefings, or position papers researching issues for government agencies, trade associations, foundations, NGOs, or advocacy agencies. (AI Contribution Types: Research Report; Technical Report)
- Other IC Type Selected by the School Research monographs and chapters within a research text (Al Contribution Types: Monograph; Book, Chapter)
