### Program: – Comprehensive Analysis

For All Business Students:
<p>All students demonstrated an above average performance on the learning outcome of Entrepreneurship Skills. This results of 93% general response is broken down into 3 specific criteria, for which the identification of opportunities is just 83% outcome. This result is barely on the lower level interval of the performance indicator. These results indicate that students need to be more open to research outside the domestic market and industries. Results show a very conservative and low innovation tendencies, which in turn diminish the learning outcome of acquiring and expanding their entrepreneurship skills.</p> <p>Instructors for this course should incorporate examples outside the domestic market of Puerto Rico and refocus students research approach toward international arena &amp; more technological areas &amp; industries.</p>
