

# Nurse Corps Scholarship Program

Program Description	We offer scholarships to help you pay for your health professions' education. In return, you work at a Critical Shortage Facility (CSF) when you graduate.
Eligible Disciplines	Accepted or enrolled in a nursing degree program at an accredited school of nursing located in the United States or U.S. territory: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Diploma School of Nursing</li> <li>• Associate Degree School of Nursing (ADN)</li> <li>• Collegiate School of Nursing (BSN, graduate degree)</li> <li>• Graduate-Level Nurse Practitioner</li> <li>• Nursing Bridge Program (RN to BSN, RN to MSN-NP, Direct Entry MSN-NP)</li> </ul>
Service Commitment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2-year minimum service commitment for 1–2 years of scholarship support (full-time status)</li> <li>• 1-year additional service commitment per scholarship year for full-time students who need scholarship support for more than 2 years (4 years maximum support)</li> <li>• Full-time status: Minimum of 32 hours per week, for at least 45 weeks per year. 26 hours must be spent providing clinical services to patients.</li> </ul>
Financial Benefits	Funding for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tuition</li> <li>• Required fees</li> <li>• Monthly support stipend</li> <li>• Annual other reasonable educational costs (e.g., books, supplies, uniforms)</li> </ul>
