A SHORT-TERM COMMITMENT WITH LONG-TERM REWARDS

Finish your term and move on if you like. After just four years (for most job fields), you're free to take your training and your skills and offer them on the civilian market – where you'll have a large competitive edge over your civilian competition. If you decide to stay, you'll begin seeing increased flexibility in terms of where you live and what work you choose. If you pursue graduate school, the Navy will pay for it, and all your college time will count toward retirement at 20 years.

WHAT IT TAKES

To participate in the Navy BDCP, you must:

- Be enrolled or accepted at a four-year accredited college or university with no NROTC program
- Be enrolled as a full-time student
- Have completed 60 semester hours or 90 quarter hours
- Have at least a 2.8 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Be at least 19 years old
- Meet the Navy's physical requirements

WHAT'S NEXT

Once you've been selected, you must:

- Maintain full-time student status
- Submit official transcript upon completion of each school term (semester/quarter)
- Pay all school-related expenses
- Graduate on time

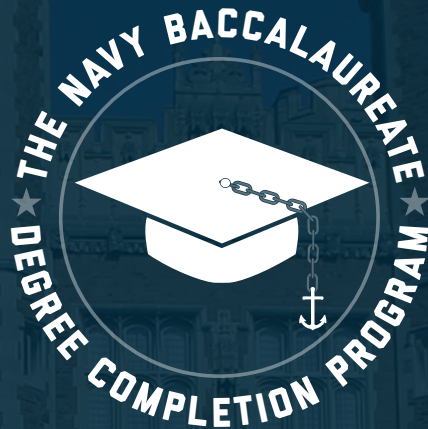
