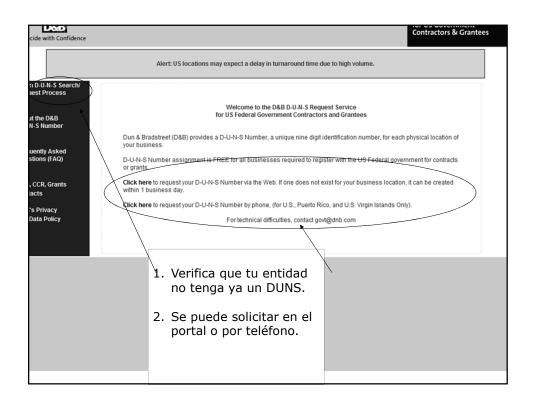

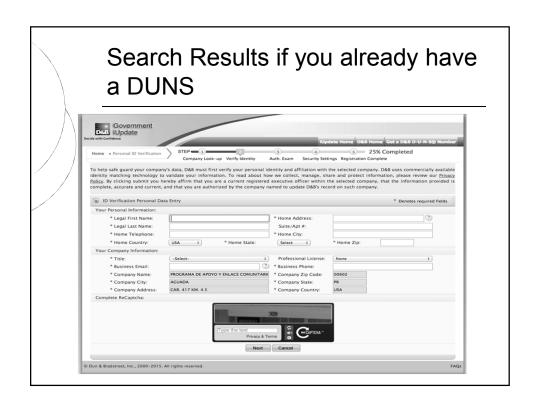
## What you need to apply for grants or contracts with Federal Government?

- Obtain a **DUNS** number <a href="http://fedgov.dnb.com/webform/display-">http://fedgov.dnb.com/webform/display-</a> <a href="http://energy.documents.com/webform/display-">HomePage.do</a>
- 2. Register with **SAM** (System for Award Management) <a href="http://www.sam.gov">http://www.sam.gov</a>
- Organizational Registration with Grants.gov

#### 1. What is the D-U-N-S Number?


- Data Universal Numbering System is a nine digit number which uniquely identifies an individual business.
- The U.S. government and many major corporations require their suppliers and contractors to have a D-U-N-S Number

- $\circ\,$  It is free and requested by internet
- The first step is verifying online if your organization already has a DUNS number.

#### 2. System for Award Management (SAM)

- Official U.S. Government Database system that consolidated CCR/FedReg, ORCA, and EPLS
- Required for any institution (private, NPO, government) desiring to do business with the <u>federal government</u>.
- Requires some information like: DUNS number, company name, Federal Tax Identification Number (TIN ó EIN), location, receipts, employee numbers, web site address, business type, NAICS code, Financial Information, and Point of Contact (POC) Information.
- o Registration is FREE, might take a week.



#### What is Grants.gov?


- A Federal web page that allows users to electronically find, apply for, and manage Federal Grant Opportunities.
- Creates a centralized, on-line process to find and apply for over 1000 grant programs from the 26 Federal grantmaking agencies.


#### 3. Grants.gov Registration


- o Registration is Free
- Need to have your Duns number, and an active SAM Registration.
- Grants.gov registration and instructions at:










#### Recommendations


- Register to receive alerts of funding opportunities from Grants.gov
- Do a quick check of the program announcements (<u>deadline</u>, <u>eligibility</u>, <u>matching</u> <u>requirements</u>, etc) until you find one that suits your needs
- 3. Be aware of the new e-Government registration requirements for submitting proposals to apply for Federal Funds
- 4. Use the Find and Apply Guide at Grants.gov

- 5. Start early!!!





## Tips for Searching Opportunities

- Use key words and come up with combinations
- o Do not give up, it is a time intensive task
- Take your time to scan Agency websites
- Found a good but closed opportunity?
   Keep the CFDA for searching again, most programs will repeat the opportunity.
   Also you could get information about what proposals were funded in the past...

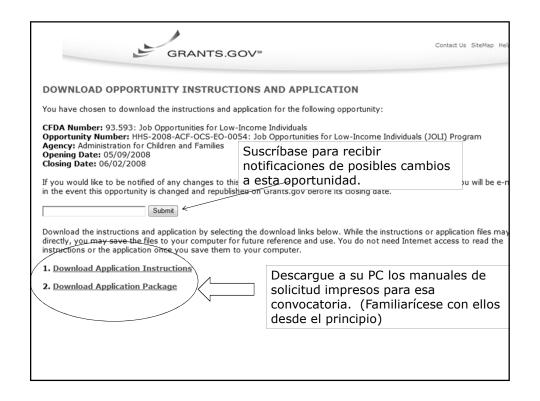

# Tips for Completing Application Package

- Espacios amarillo son campos obligatorios de la solicitud. Se marcan como errores y no permiten la radicación si no los llena.
- Siga al pie de la letra las instrucciones de los formularios. (i.e. incluir todos los anejos en un sólo archivo vs muchos archivos separados)
- Recuerde que los formularios de solicitud son las instrucciones de esa Agencia particular.

- Normalmente anejos en formato pdf es requerido en algunas agencias. (Use pdf creator ó Primo PD entre otros.)
- Trabaje el presupuesto en Excel antes de entrar la solicitud en los Application's R&R Budget Forms
- Grants.gov hace un cotejo mínimo de que la solicitud cumpla con los requerimientos en sistema ante de redirigir su solicitud a la agencia particular.
  - Siga las instrucciones
  - Sea minucioso.
