LETTER OF AGREEMENT

The University of Puerto Rico at Mayagüez (UPRM) and its CoHemis Center, the Division of Educational Programs at Argonne National Laboratory, and the Roberto Clemente Community Academy High School agree to implement and conduct a program for stimulating Clemente students to positively consider jobs and careers in science, mathematics and engineering, and for inducing those with appropriate skills in mathematics and science to excel in those subjects and pursue careers as scientists, mathematicians or engineers. Specific components of the program to be conducted by each party follow:

Clemente's Administration:

- will facilitate and coordinate the program's activities for its students at its premises and stimulate participation;
- will distribute to the appropriate students the information provided by the other parties;
- will continue to include UPRM in future Cultural and Educational Immersion Trips to Puerto Rico; and
- will include Argonne National Laboratory among its sites of interest for field trips.

Division of Educational Programs, Argonne National Laboratory:

- will actively seek to include Clemente faculty and students in its educational visits, programs, lectures, and other educational activities;
- will send twice in the first year and subsequently once a year a Hispanic (preferably Puerto Rican) engineer or scientist to speak in English and Spanish to Clemente Seniors and other students who may opt for engineering/science careers. This person will be a role model and provide career orientation;
- may send additional speakers to provide information, career orientation, and fulfill other related objectives;
- may send speakers to UPRM to address its students and/or pre-college students upon request by UPRM; and
- will sponsor enrichment activities to prepare Clemente students for academic success.

The University of Puerto Rico's Mayagüez Campus and its CoHemis Center:

- will occasionally send faculty or students to speak to Clemente faculty and students about the Mayagüez Campus, financial aid, and engineering/science careers.
- will send application forms and information for prospective Clemente applicants.
- will provide orientation and tutorial programs to Clemente graduates who are admitted to and enroll at UPRM.

• will coordinate relevant visits to UPRM and related activities at the request of the other parties.

All three parties agree to inform each other of any activities carried on as part of this agreement. Any party may terminate its part in the agreement by serving notice to the other two parties two months in advance. The agreement may be amended by any of the parties upon acceptance by the other two parties.
