## **Evidence Overview**

### The Evidence

This evidence presents that the average passing rate for UPRM teacher candidates taking the General PCMAS test over the past three years is 94% for the Secondary Level and 100% for the Elementary level. This reflects the UPRM EPP emphasis on breadth and depth of content knowledge, the rigor of UPRM general education requirements, and the teaching professional competencies. Table 2 compares the passing rates of UPRM graduates on the Puerto Rico Teacher Certification exam, General PCMAS over the past three years with all test takers.

#### Puerto Rico Teacher Certification Exam – General PCMAS Results 2020-2023

The General PCMAS test measures teachers' knowledge and skills to perform efficiently. The content of the basic university courses offered in the various higher education institutions is considered in its preparation. The Fundamental Knowledge and Professional Skills exercises are multiple selections and last approximately two hours and twenty minutes. In addition, the test includes a pedagogical situation with discussion exercises that are answered in thirty-five minutes. The content areas of the test are as follows.

### Fundamental Knowledge:

- Social Sciences
- Humanities
- Natural Sciences
- Math
- Spanish
- English

### **Professional Competencies:**

- Methodology
- Evaluation and Research
- Educational Philosophy
- Educational Sociology
- Human development
- Educational psychology

Analysis of a pedagogical situation

The General PCMAS is offered at Secondary (middle and high school) and Elementary levels. The exams are offered on a Saturday in March of each calendar year. A subsequent table provides a year-by-year comparison in greater detail. See 2023.1.3.4 for the current PRDE Circular Letter 04-2022-2023 regulating PCMAS administration and purposes.

The average passing rate for UPRM teacher candidates taking the General PCMAS test over the past three years is 94% for the Secondary Level and 100% for the Elementary level. This reflects the UPRM EPP emphasis on breadth and depth of content knowledge, the rigor of UPRM general education requirements, and the teaching professional competencies. # General PCMAS - Puerto Rico Teacher Certification Exam Results 2020-2023

Historically, a UPRM teacher candidate scored highest on the yearly General PCMAS - Puerto Rico Teacher Certification exams. Given that UPRM teacher candidates account for 20% of the test takers for the certification exam, this attests to their consistent quality. A UPRM teacher candidate has made one of the top three scores on the Secondary Level Professional Skills Exam for the past three years. The following table compares UPRM candidate performance with all Puerto Rico on the General PCMAS - Puerto Rico Teacher Certification Exams over the past three years. The minimum passing scale score established for the General PCMAS (General at the elementary level and General at the secondary level) is 89.
