JOB DESCRIPTION AND DUTIES

The Department of Animal Science, University of Puerto Rico – Mayagüez Campus, is seeking candidates for a 9-month tenure-track position for an Assistant Professor with a PhD in Animal Sciences, with emphasis in Welfare of farm animals (e.g., Swine or Poultry). The appointment is 75% teaching and 25% research. The candidate will teach courses related to non-ruminant farm animals and perform research tasks in poultry or swine, with emphasis on animal welfare.
