INTRODUCTION

The University of Puerto Rico, Mayagüez Campus is currently seeking candidates for teaching and research in the fields of clinical psychology or school psychology.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have a Ph.D. in School Psychology or Clinical Psychology or have completed all degree requirements by date of hire.

1. Applicants must hold a doctoral degree in Clinical Psychology or School Psychology (Ph.D., Psy.D., or Ed.D.), or have completed all degree requirements by the hiring date.
2. A current psychologist license issued by the Puerto Rico Board of Examiners of Psychologists, or an EPPP certification, or a license that can be validated in Puerto Rico.
3. Training or experience in quantitative and qualitative research.
4. Evidence of publications and presentations in professional forums.
5. Willingness to develop and submit proposals for external funding.
6. Teaching experience at the graduate and/or undergraduate level.
7. Spanish and English proficiency in oral and written communication.
8. Experience in assessment and intervention with school-age populations.
9. Training in the administration of cognitive, socio-emotional, and/or psychoeducational psychological tests.
10. Willingness to supervise graduate and undergraduate students in clinical and school practice settings.

It is desirable, but not required, to have:

1. Knowledge and skills in using technology for distance learning.
2. Experience in community practice.
3. Interpersonal skills and teamwork abilities.
4. Experience providing mentorship at the graduate and/or undergraduate level (dissertations, research, and/or projects).

JOB DESCRIPTION AND DUTIES

A full-time probationary psychology professional is responsible for teaching and supervising graduate and undergraduate students in the areas of Clinical Psychology or School Psychology. The selected candidate is expected to plan, organize, and teach in a manner that ensures the institution's learning objectives are met. They should contribute to the institution's academic development by participating in the creation of new courses, institutional and departmental committees, evaluation, research, mentoring, teaching, and community service.

The hire will be required to teach undergraduate and graduate psychology courses, provide mentorship services to graduate and undergraduate students, and offer services to the department, faculty, university, community, and profession. Our goal is to hire an outstanding professional with a current license who can adapt to our academic culture.
