INTRODUCTION

The University of Puerto Rico at Mayagüez is seeking qualified applicants for a tenure-track faculty position who are interested in teaching and research in Physics.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must hold a Ph.D. in Physics or its equivalent by date of hire. Relevant experience in postdoctoral research positions will be valued. We invite candidates in High Energy Physics with expertise in Experimental, Theoretical, or Computational fields to apply. The selected candidate must commit to excellence in undergraduate and graduate teaching and is expected to actively seek external funding to support their research activities. If the applicant's native language is not Spanish, they must initially be able to communicate and teach fluently in English and, by the end of the five-year evaluation period, be able to communicate effectively in Spanish.

JOB DESCRIPTION AND DUTIES

The selected candidate is expected to develop creative research activities relevant to their field, interact with researchers and students in the Department of Physics, advise graduate and undergraduate students on research projects, publish research results in peer-reviewed conferences and journals, attract external funding for their research activities; and contribute to education, outreach, and workforce development activities in physics. Moreover, the selected candidate is expected to teach physics courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels, contribute to the assessment and continuous improvement of our academic programs, participate in faculty committees, collaborate in outreach activities, and support the academic service activities carried out by the Department.


