INTRODUCTION

The University of Puerto Rico at Mayagüez is seeking applicants interested in teaching and conducting research in Atmospheric Physics.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must hold a Ph.D. in Physics by date of hire. Relevant experience in postdoctoral research positions is highly valued. We are seeking applications from candidates in Atmospheric Physics. The successful candidate must commit to excellence in undergraduate and graduate teaching and is expected to actively seek external funding to support their research activities. If the applicant's native language is not Spanish, they should initially be able to communicate and teach fluently in English and, by the end of the five-year evaluation period, be able to communicate effectively in Spanish.

JOB DESCRIPTION AND DUTIES

The selected candidate is expected to develop creative research activities relevant to their field, interact with researchers and students in the Department of Physics, advise graduate and undergraduate students on research projects, publish research results in peer-reviewed conferences and journals, attract external funding for their research activities; and contribute to education, outreach, and workforce development activities in physics. Moreover, the selected candidate is expected to teach physics courses at the undergraduate level and atmospheric sciences courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels. They should also contribute to the continuous improvement and assessment activities of our academic programs, participate in faculty committees, collaborate in outreach activities, and support the general academic service activities of the Department.
