INTRODUCTION

Academic degrees should preferably be from a university recognized and/or accredited by an accrediting agency for engineering and technology programs (ABET or equivalent). It is desirable that you have experience in teaching at the university level and/or CIAPR Engineering License. Candidates are expected to possess professional experience in their field and to be academically qualified to teach in at least one of the following specialties:

JOB DESCRIPTION AND DUTIES

Candidates considered for part-time appointment will have an academic load of less than 12 credits per semester. It will be distributed in teaching and other related tasks, which include office hours. The relationship between the candidate and the University of Puerto Rico – Mayagüez Campus and Department will be developed in accordance with all applicable laws, regulations, certifications, and official guidelines, including Certification 16-17-242 and Certification 16-17-307 as amended, as established by the Mayagüez Campus Administrative Board. You can review all the aforementioned provisions through the official website of the UPR-RUM (<http://www.uprm.edu/portada/>). The responsibilities will be those described in Articles 63, 64 and 65 of the General Regulations of the University of Puerto Rico. The academic load will be assigned by the Director of the Department in coordination with the Dean of Engineering. The appointments will be effective during the academic period of the first or second semester of the 2026-2027 academic year according to certifications in the academic calendar and the Administrative Board. The party hired as teaching staff, by signing, accepts and agrees that they will comply with the contact hours required per course, as well as with all the hours inherent to teaching. If, as a result of extraordinary or unforeseen circumstances, the administration authorizes the extension of the semester, the obligations of the professor will continue until the teaching task is completed without remuneration or benefit. Candidates must participate in professional development activities that help improve and enhance teaching and curriculum development skills. Candidates must be fluent in both written and verbal languages: English and Spanish.

2. Curriculum Vitae
3. Transcript (transcripts pertinent to the BS, MS or Ph.D. degree depending on the terminal degree obtained)
4. Listing with name and contact information for three (3) references
5. Optional Documents
 - a. Student assessments (if you have previous teaching experience and if assessments are available)
 - b. Professional License Certification (PE, EIT, etc.)
 - c. Professional Certifications (eg. Project Management, OSHA, etc.)
 - d. Virtual Educator Certifications (for non-face-to-face courses)
 - e. Evidence from research, presentations, and publications in scientific journals
