## INTRODUCTION

The Department of English at the University of Puerto Rico at Mayagüez (UPRM) seeks applicants for a tenure-track position at the level of Assistant Professor **starting July 1, 2023**.

## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants should have completed a doctoral degree in 20<sup>th</sup> or 21<sup>st</sup> century Poetry in English at the start of the appointment. Teaching, research experience, and publications expected. Knowledge of Spanish is recommended. Preferred areas of expertise include British and American modernism. Candidates whose teaching and research interests explore the intersection of modernism with colonization, the visual arts, and environmentalism are particularly welcome to apply.

## JOB DESCRIPTION

Responsibilities include teaching poetry and introductory literature to our general student population and to students completing the Bachelor's degree in English, as well as graduate courses in Poetry from 1900 to the present. Candidates should demonstrate adequate skills in educational technologies in the teaching-learning process. They should also be able to conduct research and publish in the areas of specialization; to develop proposals seeking external funding; to teach basic, intermediate and advanced courses in the area of specialization; to participate actively in departmental committees, projects, and investigation at the undergraduate and graduate level.

This appointment involves an academic task equivalent to 12 credit hours, which are distributed between teaching, research and institutional services for 37.5 hours a week.
