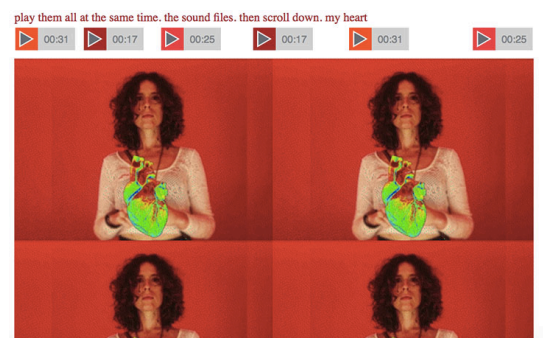
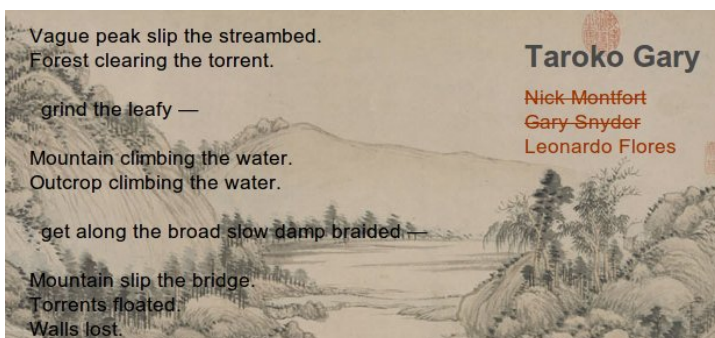
SPRING 2019 COURSES

INGL 3175: E-POETRY WRITING

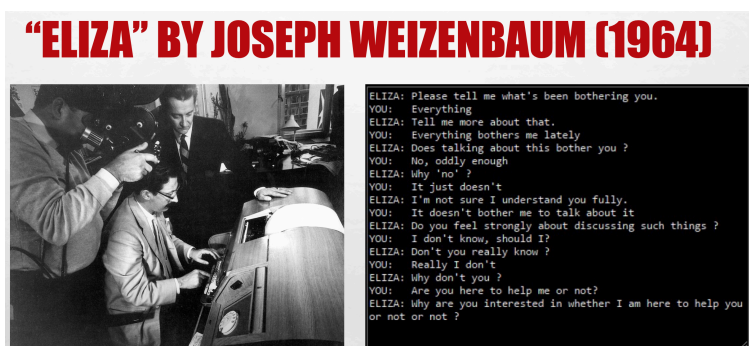

INGL 3300: THREE GENERATIONS OF ELECTRONIC LITERATURE

Discover electronic literature through a historical framework that organizes it into three generations: pre-Web (1951-1995), Web (1995-present), and post-Web (2005-present). Learn about new genres such as: computational literature, bots, interactive fiction, hypertext fiction, e-poetry, videopoetry, videogames, net.art, and more. E-literature shows us the future of literature in a post-print world.
