The Berkeley Engineering Preview Day is designed for rising seniors who are interested in applying to PhD programs in engineering.

## Over the course of 3 days, participants will:

- Meet individually with faculty members
- Attend workshops on the graduate admissions and funding process and learn how to put together a competitive application to UC Berkeley
- Receive advice on maximizing his/her upcoming summer research opportunity
- Network with researchers from national laboratories and engineering research centers
- Interact with current UC Berkeley graduate students
- Tour the Berkeley campus and visit San Francisco
- Airfare, accommodations and meals provided

Participants will receive ongoing advising from the Engineering Graduate Outreach office throughout the summer and admissions cycle.

## Eligibility:

- Academic goal is a PhD in an engineering discipline
- Intend to apply for graduate school this fall (2015)
- Minimum 3.5 GPA
- Must be a US Citizen or Permanent Resident
